The September 2026 draw has now taken place and **congratulations to the following winners:**

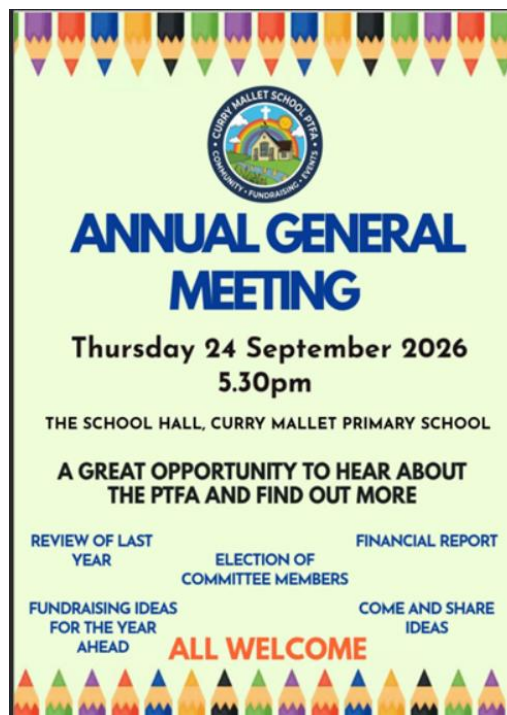
1st prize £25 – Sarah and Jack Westworth (no.42)
